2. With this, please be advised that all unused answer sheets (ASs) in the morning of the first day of the test shall be collected during the monitoring of the DTCs, RTCs and other designated monitoring personnel. Second session may be conducted in the afternoon to accommodate those who will not be allocated with test materials in the morning. Test booklets may be reused in the second session, as well as all the collected unused ASs.
3. In the event that there would be no unused ASs, the SDOs may request for another schedule of test administration. The request shall be accompanied by a report that 100% of the ASs were used during the original schedule of test administration. The new schedule of test shall be determined by this office upon the nationwide retrieval of the test materials.
