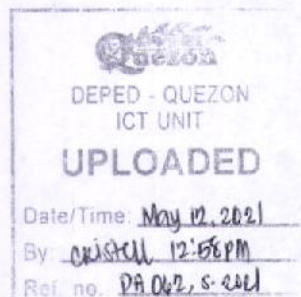
INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN SEAMEO-RELATED EVENTS 2021



2. Call for Abstracts: SEAMEO SEN's 4th International Conference on Special Education (ICSE) 2021


