



Greetings from the University of the Philippines Los Baños!


The Language Instruction Towards Excellence (LITE) Program of CAS-UPLB is delighted to invite you and your constituents to "Code-Switching in Language Classes and Related Conversation", a webinar aimed for teachers and learners to be held on July 27, 2022 at 1PM, via Zoom. This webinar is free and a certificate will be issued to attendees.

In the context of Philippine education, code-switching has long been practiced within the classrooms, and now in online platforms, by both teachers and learners as it is used as a strategy to aid in teaching and learning. However, this conversation can be more nuanced when it comes to its use in language classes. The goal of this webinar is to explore the practice of code-switching by teachers and learners in language classes, particularly in English and Filipino, and related conversations.

Prof. Precious Sarah A. Añoso, a faculty member of the Language Division of the UPLB CAS Department of Humanities, presents three perspectives to tackle the topic: "The sociolinguistic perspective explains the social motivations and factors in code switching among learners, the language learning perspective explores the potential effects of code switching in attaining proficiency in the target language, and the language teaching perspective explores the role of the teachers in the learners' code switching practices in language classes and related conversations."

The webinar is part of UPLB LITE's extension activities, which aims to provide an online place for knowledge sharing and co-creation with different UPLB students, faculty, and staff.
