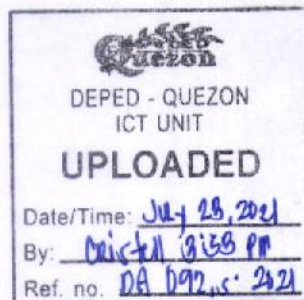
USAPANG BAKAWAN AT KABATAAN: IKAW, AKO, TAYO ANG KALIKASAN

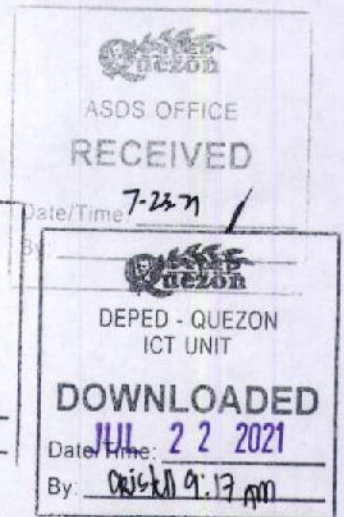
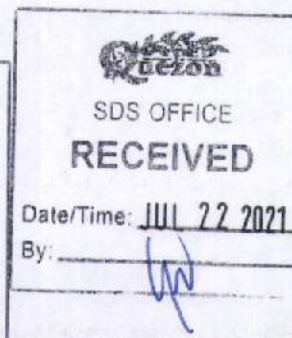
Target participants to this activity are Grade 7 to 11 learners. Interested participants are reminded of the following conditions:
